I have received a call from Mike Van Grunsven, representing U. S. Fire Insurance Company. He advises me that the insurance carrier will pay on a conceded basis 75 percent of the evaluation of disability issued by Dr. Gingrass. We understand there is as yet a dispute as to the amount of permanent partial disability.

Concerning payment of compensation for disfigurement, this is paid in percisely the same fashion that compensation for permanent disability is paid. In other words, it is paid on a periodic basis and becomes a part of the money due for permanent disability. It is not the policy of the department that disfigurement is paid in a lump sum.

Do you want a hearing scheduled on the issue of permanent disability and disfigurement?
